

Open Burning

Open burning is allowed by permit on approved days only, as provided by State Law. Permits are available at the Fire Marshal's Office during normal business hours Monday thru Friday, 8:30 to 12:00 and 1:00 to 4:30.

The permit allows for the burning of brush only (branches under Three (3) inches in diameter) and garden clippings. Building debris, garbage or leaves are not permitted to be burned. The fire must be on property owned by and lived on by the permit applicant.

The applicant must call the provided number for approval, and can only burn after 10:00am and must have the fire extinguished by 5:00pm. Burning on weekends is allowed. The cost of the permit is \$10.00 and is good for 2 weeks from the date of issue.

The permit may be revoked by the Burning Official at any time for failure to follow the conditions of the permit. Burning will not be allowed during high fire danger alerts or poor air quality days as determined by the State or the Local Burning Official.
